Tonight, Tuesday, 12/10 -- Land Use, 7pm, City Council Chamber -- Agenda includes further discussion and possible vote on the **Ascend marijuana** dispensary special permit. I would expect they will try to vote, since it's the last Land Use meeting before the last scheduled full Council meeting of the term. It's in the middle of a long agenda, so it's hard to tell what time it will come up. The major unresolved concern is the exit onto Cross Street. 
